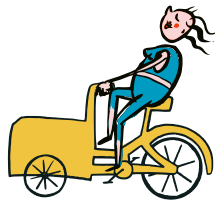

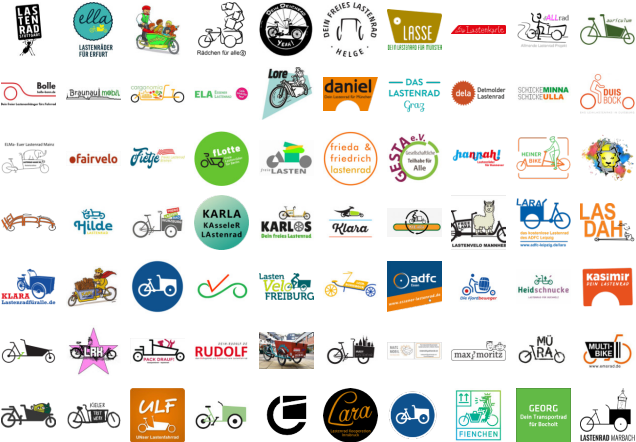

Initiative and bike count as of June 2020.

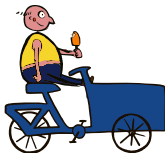
A „commons cargo bike“:
