

KASIMIR — your cargo bike

- Launched 2013 with one bike („KASIMIR“)
- Host system: Bikes are at community centres, cafés, shops
- Goal: Low administration effort and cost-effective to run
- Custom booking system

Sharing principles

- Free (donation-based) cargo bike sharing
- A „common good“: to be shared instead of individually owned
- Neighbourhood cooperation
- Personal contact: When you book a bike, you'll meet a human
