- ... cargo bikes can be quite expensive!






Making sustainable mobility visible and accessible

- Free (donation-based) cargo bike sharing
- Local multipliers host the bike(s), personal contact establishes the service as part of the community
- Low administration effort and cost-effective to run


Commons Cargobike principles






A "Commons Cargobike"

- makes cargo bikes available to all free of charge (donation-based)
- is a **"common good**": to be shared instead of individually owned.
- is advocating for a change of mind in urban transportation, and represents resource conservation & sustainable traffic
- relies on neighborhood cooperation:
 Cafés, private citizens and institutions are acting as pickup location



1. Cargobike hosts (locations)

- Bikes are located at the local café, the community center, the university...
- The hosts handle the pickup and return
- Hosting the bike is good marketing opportunity for the hosts, it attracts new customers








2. Booking software

CommonsBooking:

- Custom open-source software, designed for the needs of Commons Cargobike initiatives
- Simple online booking of 1-3 days
- People pick up the bike with their ID and a code
- Automated process

Commons Cargobike network






Milestones

- 88 active independent initiatives, 12 in development
- Countries: Austria, Germany, Hungary, Sweden
- ~ 400 bikes available: Biggest cargo bike sharing provider in Germany!




